Overview and Goal of the Game

A player must ingest in the trusted digital repository (TDR) all file format cards he has in hand. To do that, he must get all characteristic and action card listed on his file format card.

Number of players: between 3 to 7

Quick game: for five players or more, only draw two file format cards.

Start

- All players take three file format cards and five other cards. All cards a player can't use must be discarded in an open discard pile.
- For this round, all special cards must be discarded.
- The game is played with open hand – cards on the table in front of the player except for the special cards that can be kept in hand.
- The last person who used a non-proprietary file format begins

Play

- A player can pick a card or make an action.
 - o A player can pick a card from the pile of new cards or from the open discard pile (he can only pick the one on top)
 - o An action is the use of a special card or to ingest a file format in the TDR.
- A player can only keep cards he can use – he must discard all characteristic and action cards he doesn't need.
- The first to ingest all his file format cards wins!
